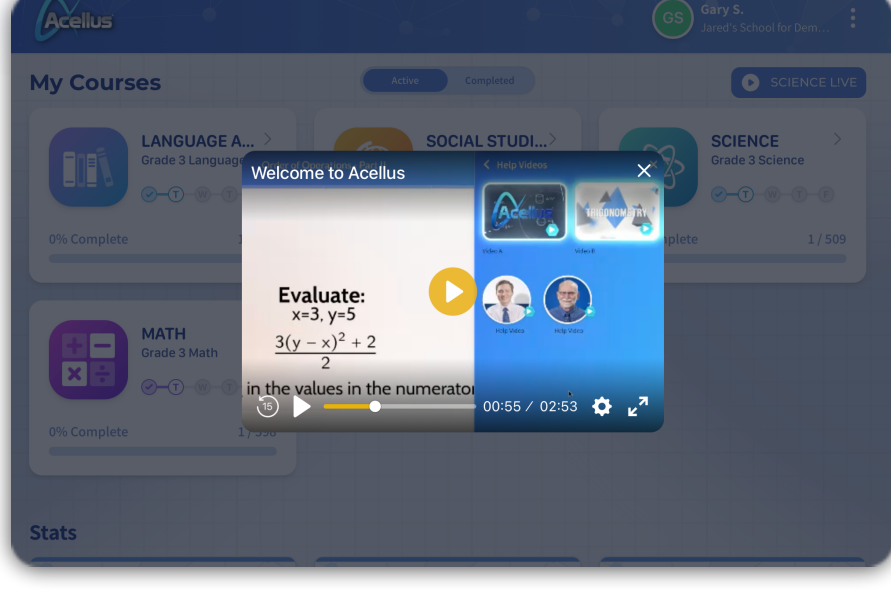

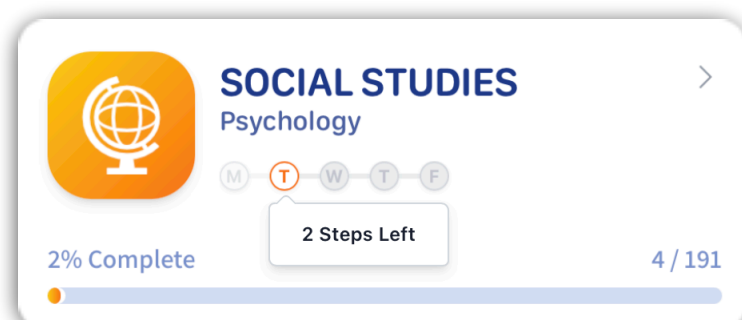
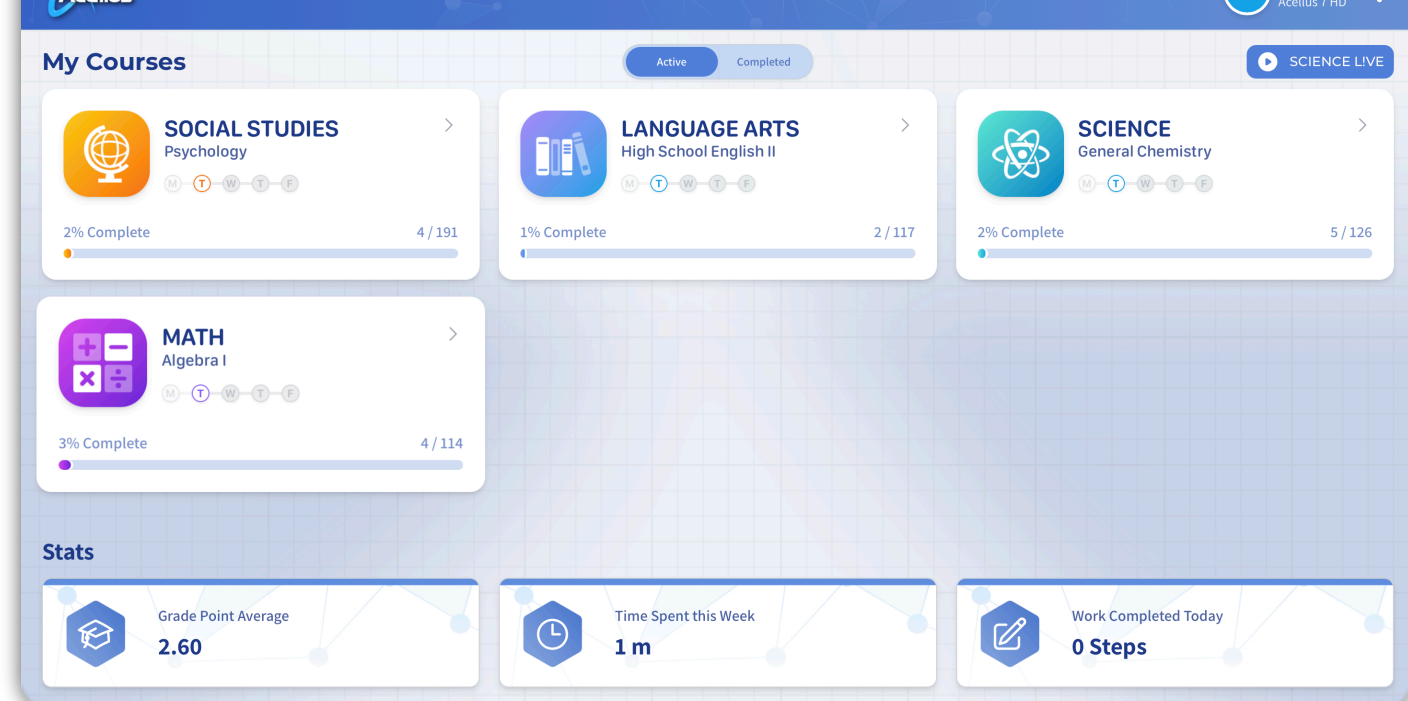
Student Interface - Acellus 7 HD

This tutorial will navigate the student interface while exploring the various functions and help resources available to students.

When students first sign in, they will be welcomed with an **'Orientation Video'** that is specific to the interface they are in.

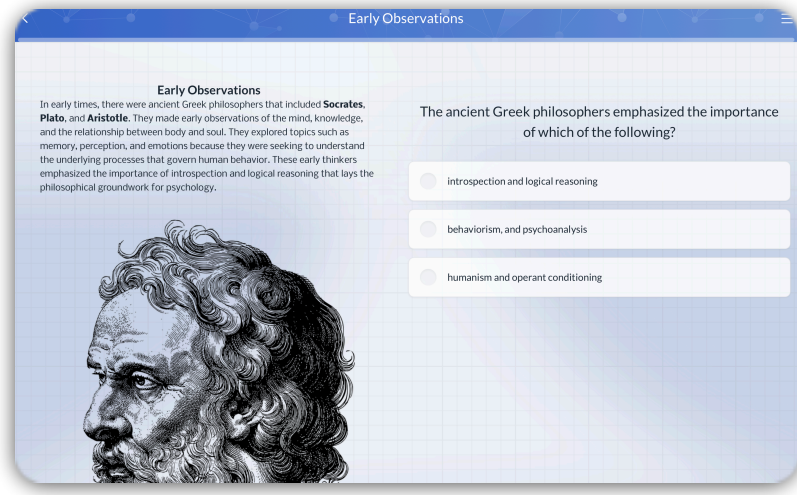


After the introduction video, students will be directed to the **'Course Page'**, where they can view all the courses they are currently enrolled in. Clicking on a course will resume the students progress from where they last left off.



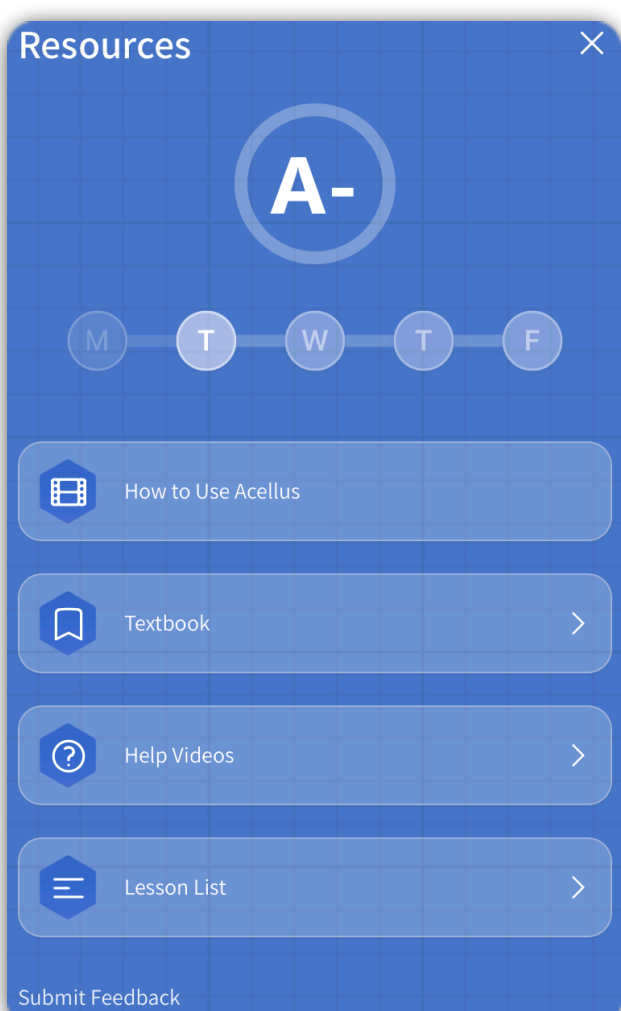
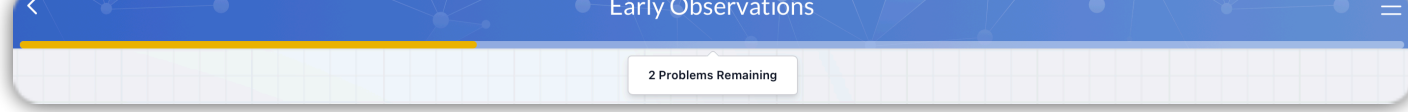
'Course Tiles' have a "Goal Status Indicator" that shows progress for each day of the week. When students mouse over it, they can see how many steps are left to complete their daily goal.

Lessons are short and concise, usually focusing on just one concept or learning objective.



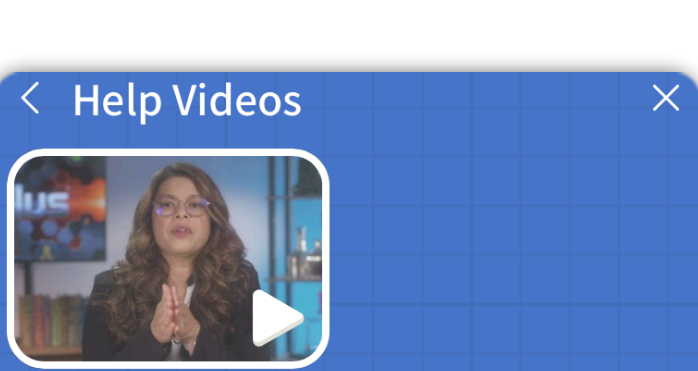
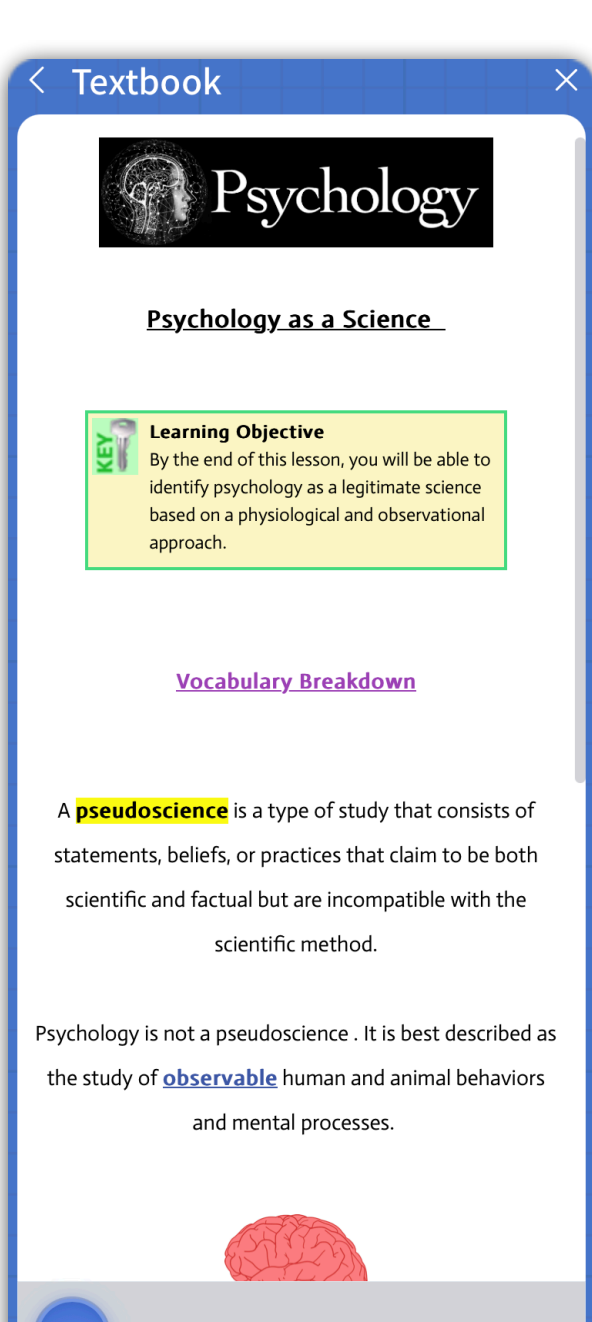
After each lesson, students are given problems to assess their understanding of the concepts.

Students will be able to check how much work is remaining in their current step by hovering over the progress bar at the top of their screen.



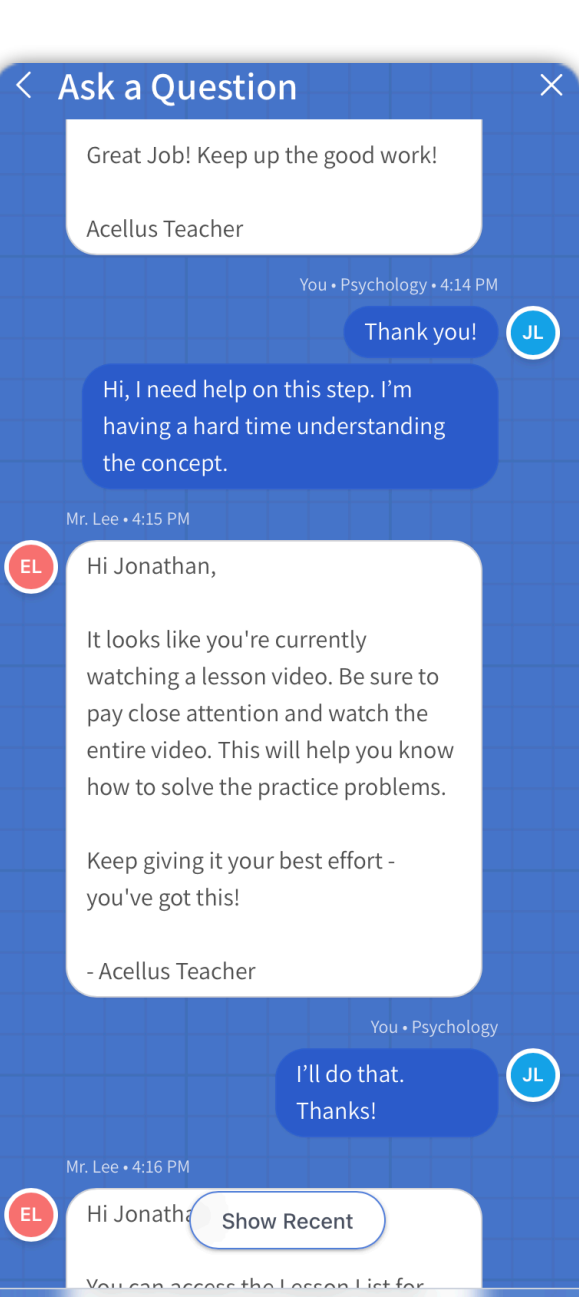
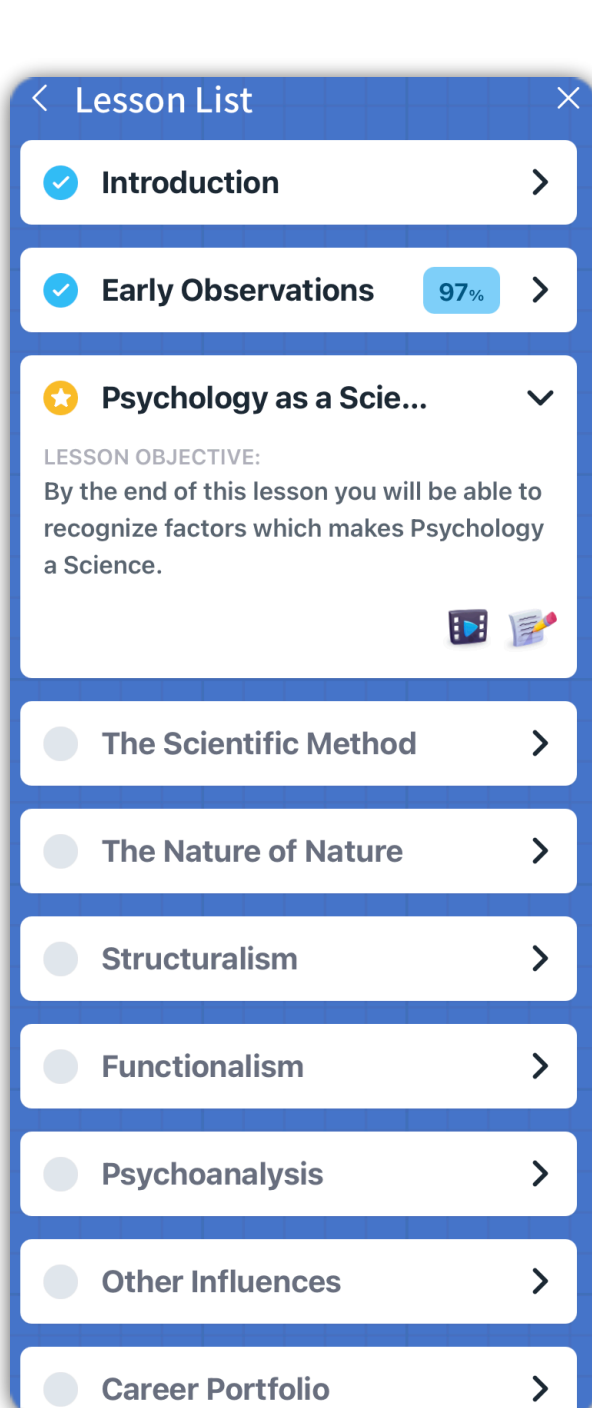
By clicking the 3-line menu tab, students can see their course grade, status of the weekly goal, and various help resources.

The **"Textbook"** resource is a written version of the concept covered in the video.



The **"Help Videos"** are additional resource videos to help students master a concept.

The **"Lesson List"** allows students to see what lessons are coming up and gives them the ability to re-watch or re-take lessons up to three times for a chance to improve their grade.



The final option available is the **"Ask a Question"** button, connecting the student directly to an active teacher monitoring the class.
